



Q1: How would you best describe yourself?



Q2: Which of these sources do you principally rely on to obtain information about the district? (Choose up to 2)













Q9: Overall, how satisfied are you with the school district?




Q10: On a scale of 1-5, 5 being very satisfied, what number best describes your satisfaction with services provided by the school district?








