

What does the Data Reveal?

- The various scenarios have a miniscule impact on the average grade
- Quarters are more closely correlated to the Regents grade than the Midterm grades average quarter grade
- For the 4 of the 5 required Regents exams (English, Living Environment, Global Regents and U.S History) required for graduation, the average Regent exam grade is greater than the average Quarter grade. (The Midterm in English is the Regents for the Honors group)
- For Algebra I the Regents is 1 point lower than the Quarter grade
- In the past 3 years the average Regents grade is within 4 points of Quarter grades for all subjects except Algebra 2015, Geometry 2016 and Physics 2016

What does the Data Reveal?

- The Regents exams are a good measure of the cumulative knowledge and skills acquired over the course of the school year
- There is a certain level of unpredictability that comes with the scales assigned to the Common Core Regents exams in Mathematics
 - When the 2016 Algebra scale is applied to the 2015 Algebra scores the average grade is increased by 5.31 points.

Recommendations

- Final Grades should be determined by the grades earned on Regents, Quarter grades and Midterm
- The impact of Midterm and Regents on the final grade should be maintained at a ratio of 2:1
- Increase the impact of Quarter grades as they are obtained using multiple measures over the quarter
- Reduce the impact of the Regents and Midterms on the final average as they are one time measures of performance

Recommendation Continued

- In the event that the Average Regents score (obtained by the entire cohort) varies by 6 or more points from the average Quarter grade, the superintendent will be granted the authority to readjust the scale to provide a local Regents score for calculation into the Final Grade.
- The official Regents grade obtained from the State scale for that year will appear on the transcript unadjusted, as is required by regulations; however, the final average will be obtained using the readjusted local Regents grade.

Recommendation Continued

- Rescale the 2015 Algebra Regents exam using the 2016 Algebra scale and recalculate the final averages using the adjusted Regents grade
- Move from a 80/13/7% formula to 84/11/5 %
- The new grading criteria should be applied to the calculation of 2016-17 grades
