Mr. Murray welcomed everyone to the meeting and asked everyone to look at the minutes. There were no questions or concerns and the minutes were approved.

Jamie Simon inquired about the SUPA Calculus and the weighting of the grades. Mr. Murray clarified the recommendations to the BOE and explained they have not yet made their decision. She also mentioned that the seniors are in the process of collecting nominations for the senior superlatives. Ms. Lasher reminded her that all candidates must give their approval prior to their names being released. She also stated the seniors will be ordering baseball shirts.

Kevin Lynch said the sophomores have no concerns at this time. They feel as though they are behind in their fundraising efforts and will try to make it up with it by hosting a Kam Jam tournament in the spring.

Tara Stark shared that the junior class is selling ¼ zip sweatshirts and lanyards as a fundraiser in the next few months. She also said they are looking at venues for the 2017 senior prom. They are considering Floral Park Terrace and are still visiting others.

Sam said the executive board will be amending the current SG constitution. They are focusing on changing the election process to give more students a chance to participate. He also mentioned that SG is looking to hold a food drive for a Long Island school in need. We talked about the "stuff a bus" initiative and will get more information on that. Mr. Murray was happy to hear about a potential change in the election process and commended Sam on spearheading this effort.

Mrs. Gustafson mentioned the overall disappointment with Lifetouch Photography. Ms. Lasher said she was investigating other companies and would finalize that after all yearbook pictures were complete for this year.

The clericals, teachers, and custodians had no concerns at this time.

Sam asked why the boys bathrooms are locked after 1:45pm. Mr. Murray explained it was to prevent vandalism and it is both boys and girls restrooms that are locked at the end of the academic day.
