Lainview-Old Bethpage runs 452 routes every day by our main bus vendor, WE Transport, utilizing 52 large buses and 24 vans.

ur district transports 315 students to 26 private & parochial schools and also transports 44 Special Education students to 22 special education schools.

I olstering the High School to a 9 period day requires revamping the bus schedule but can be done with no increase to next year's budget.

A ontractual obligations between various bus vendors and the POB school district allows the district to receive the best transportation prices available via the SENTCO co-op.

Tudents K – 12 will now have universal busing without an increase to the budget.

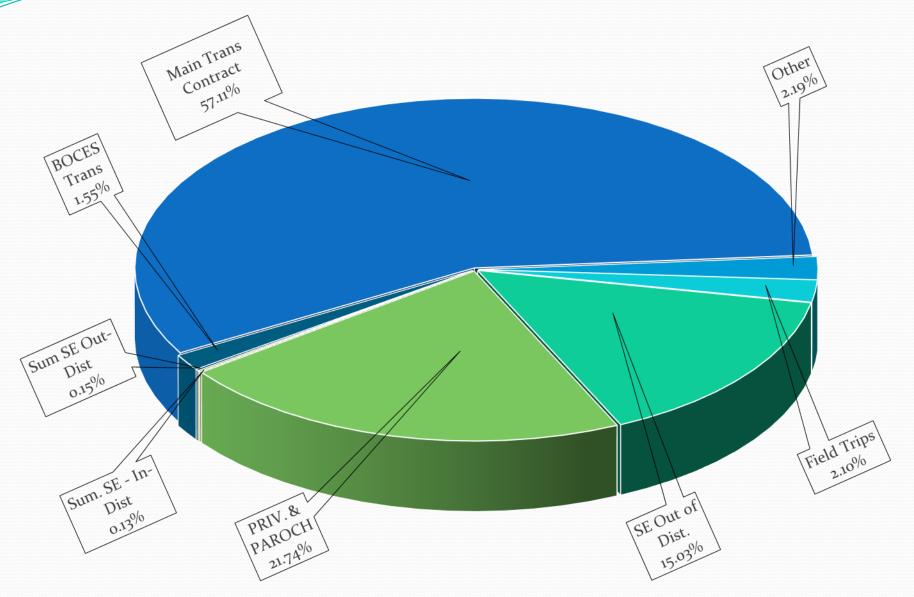
