# PRIDE Night

## Events:

### **Minute to Win It**

Students will be challenged to complete a specific task in one minute. Students will pick a task out of a hat without knowledge of what the selected task will be ahead of time. Tasks may include: balance a tennis ball on a racket without the ball falling, alphabetize teacher's names from A-Z, hop on one foot, roll dice and the two numbers must add up to 11, stack 50 cups...

### **Hula Hoop Chain Game**

Students will line up in 4 lines (one for each grade). When the race begins they must hold hands and pass a hula hoop from the beginning of the line through to the end. Once all players have successfully passed the hula hoop WITHOUT BREAKING HOLD OF EACH OTHER'S HANDS from beginning to end, they must sit down and the winner will be declared.

### **Over/Under**

Four teams will line up behind a ball. They must pass the ball "over" and "under" their bodies. When the last person gets the ball, he/she runs to the front and the team sits down.

### **Throw Ping Pong Ball Into Bucket**

Each team will be given a collection of ping pong balls. All teammates must toss the ping pong balls into an empty bucket. The ball must stay in the bucket.

### **Word Unscramble**

A word will be given to the teammates, each letter on an individual piece of paper. The teammates must sort through the letters and spell the correct word.

### **Three-Legged Challenge**

Each team will be split into pairs. Each pair will have their legs tied together. The pairs must walk from Point A to Point B. Once the first pair crosses point B, the next pair can go.

### **Dutch Auction**

A representative from each division will be called up to be the "runners" for the teams. One runner at a time will go. The host will call for an item. One runner from each team will go to their team to collect the item in question. The team that brings the item to the host will get a point. The team with the most points at the end is the winner.
